On November 10, 2012, an explosion and resulting fire occurred within the Richmond Hill subdivision in Indianapolis, Marion County, Indiana. It is alleged by the State of Indiana that this was a criminal act. The State has charged the Defendant, Mark Leonard, with two (2) counts of Murder and Felony Murder, a Felony; two (2) counts of Conspiracy to Commit Arson, as a Class A & Class B Felony; twelve (12) counts of Arson, as a Class A Felony; thirty four (34) counts of Arson, as a Class B Felony; one (1) count of Conspiracy to Commit Insurance Fraud, as a Class C Felony and one count (1) of Insurance Fraud, a Class C Felony. To these charges, the Defendant, Mark Leonard, has entered a plea of Not Guilty.
