## MOTION FOR ORDER DIRECTING THE STATE TO IDENTIFY AND DISCLOSE ALL OPINION EVIDENCE TO BE OFFERED AT TRIAL: EXPERT, SKILLED AND LAY WITNESSES

Comes now the Accused and moves the Court for an Order directing the State to Identify and disclose all opinion evidence it may introduce at the trial of this cause, and as grounds therefor says:

- 1. That the Accused anticipates that the State will offer the opinion testimony of expert, skilled and lay witnesses at the trial of this cause.
- 2. That the Accused has a right to challenge the admissibility of such opinion testimony under IRE 701, 702, 703, and 704,
- 3. That the admissibility of such opinion testimony should be resolved prior to commencement of trial to permit the parties to exclude inadmissible evidence, join their issues and shape their proof, and to avoid delay at trial and effect judicial economy.
- 4. That identification and disclosure of such opinion testimony should be ordered.
